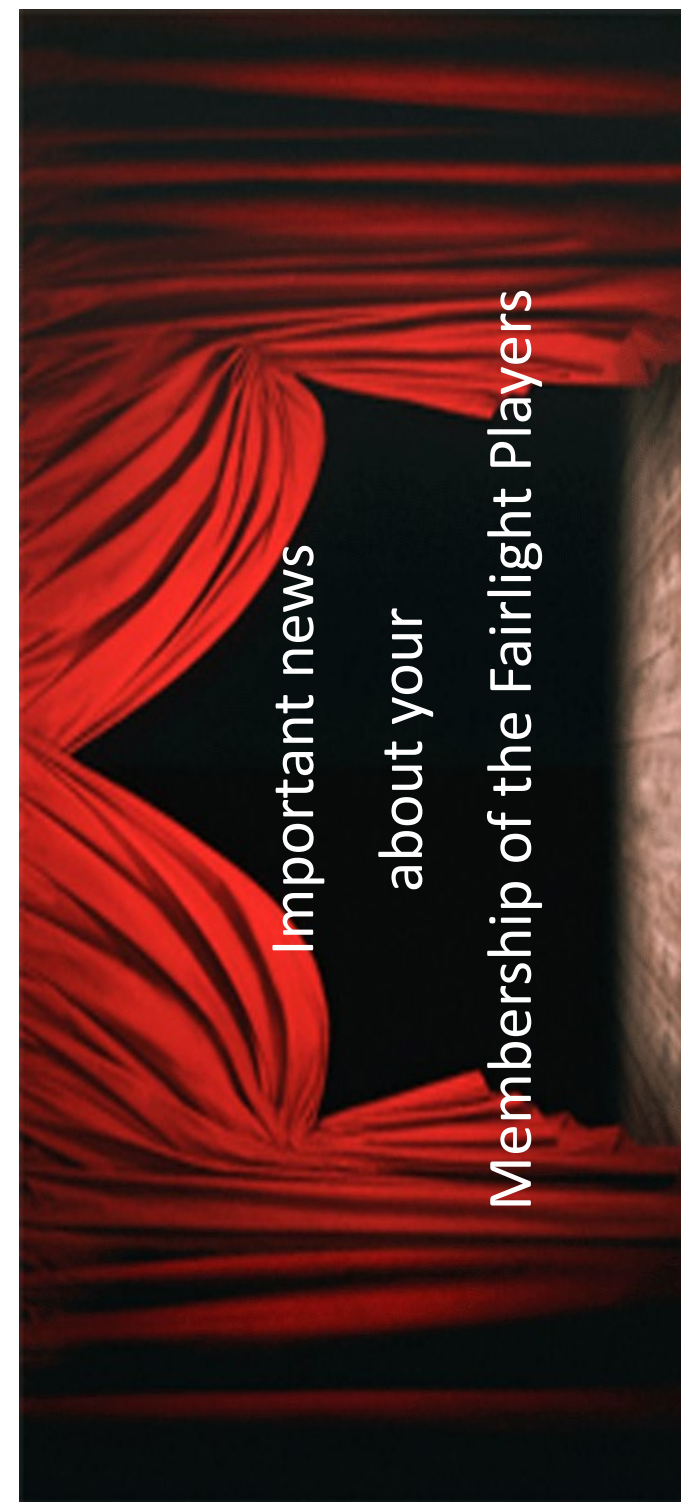

You can sign up to the scheme at any time, but payment will be due on or just after 1st May each year, entitling you to membership for the following 12 months. A receipt for payment, which will confirm your membership, will be sent (preferably by e-mail) shortly afterwards.

How to sign up ...

If you bank online, you should be able to set up a regular payment easily.



Simply enter the following details;

Sort code: 30 97 66
Account no: 01478532
Due date: 1st May (and annually)
Amount: £5 (or £10 for a couple)
Reference: Please quote your surname followed by initials (i.e. Smith, J & M)

It would help if you then send a note to tell us that you have set up the payment so that we know where to send the confirmation, and to make sure that we don't allocate your payment to the wrong J & M Smith.
